### 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Advent

This Sunday we hear about the *voice in the wilderness*, John the Baptist preparing the way for the coming of Jesus. As the Year 5 children said during their Monday morning prayer, each time they have meditated in class this year they have repeated the word *Maranatha* which means *Come, Lord Jesus*. Daily they are calling Jesus into our lives and preparing the way for him to come. **Communion** will be on Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> May with lessons beginning on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> May.

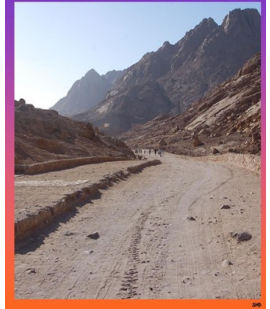
