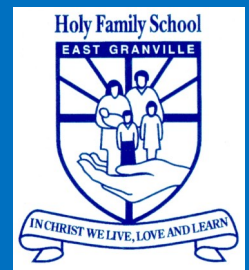

#### **Parent Learning Walk**

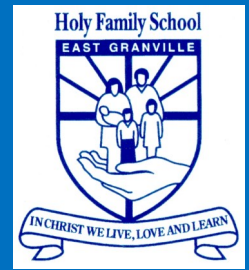
Just a reminder that we have a parent learning walk on Thursday the 18th of May at 9.15 starting in the school hall.

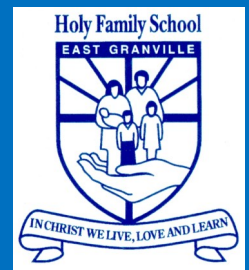

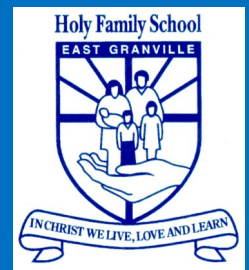
