
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MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

This year we have seen a significant shift in the learning behaviours of all students. Students are displaying motivation and confidence in all areas of learning and our tracking of student data depicts very positive growth in all key areas. Year 2 and 3 will also showcase their talents and learning. Assembly will begin at 2pm in the school Hall.

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
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Parish Spring Fair Sunday the 5th of November- 10.30 - 3pm

Enrolling at Holy Family for 2018


