Parent Interviews

During the last week of Term 2, parents are invited to make an appointment to discuss the successes and challenges of your child's academic performance so far this year.

In the past teachers have sent home letters for parents to select times and then the class teacher confirms the appointment time with another letter. This year we are using an online interview tool. This means parents can book a time with a teacher at home. Once you have selected a time, you will receive a confirmation email straight away. Please do not worry if you do not have a computer, ipad or smart phone. A laptop will be available to parents in the front office to assist you in making your appointment. If you are unable to visit the school due to work commitments you can phone and Mrs Zammit will complete your online booking for you. This is the first year we will trial this system. I have used it many times at my own daughter's school and it is very easy to use. Very clear instructions will go home next week with the letter. Please be aware that teacher times may vary from grade to grade as teachers do have many commitments after school that can not be changed. I am looking forward to hearing feedback from you regarding this system.

It is also an opportunity for parents to have a conversation with their child about how they feel about their learning and areas in which they are successful and are challenged.
