"Mary was a helpful servant to God." - *Maggie*

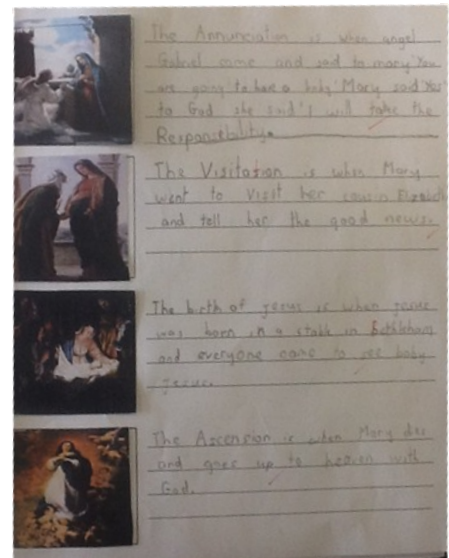
"I can be more like Mary by sharing with everyone, encouraging others and by being respectful." - *Amir*
